- 9 Start betting (6) action (Double definition - Start (filming) & Betting (US term))
- 10 Agreement to a very quiet toilet, or turned back (8) approval (Agreement - A + PP (very quiet) + Reversal (turned back) of LAV (toilet) + OR)
- 12 How the innocent apologise (6,2) pardon me (Apologise - The innocent will have been pardoned)
- 13 Sweeney cycling for a cream cake (6) eclair (Cream cake - CLAIRE (Sweeney) with last latter cycled)
- 15 Content is set after short day (12) satisfaction (Content - IS + FACTION (set) after SAT (shortened day))
- 18 Changing area of plasterboard (8,4) dressing room (Changing area - DRESSING (plaster) + ROOM (board, as in bed and board))
- 21 One may be a servant (6) yeoman (Servant - (ONE MAY)\* (anagram = may be))
- 22 Spooner's girl is enthusiastic about tofu (4,4) bean curd (Tofu - Spoonerism of KEEN BIRD (girl is enthusiastic))
- 24 Neo-nazis' key principal (3-5) alt-right (Neo-nazis' - ALT (computer key) + RIGHT (principal))
- 25 Foetal position after serving beer with half a chip (6) breech (Foetal position - BEER\* (anagram=serving) + CH[ip] (half the word) )
- 26 Put under transport returning to river, almost (8) submerge (Put under - Reversal (returning) of BUS (transport) + MERSE[y] (river, almost))
- 27 Good advice after pilot's rubbish landing? (3-3) fly-tip (Rubbish landing - TIP (good advice) after FLY (pilot, a plane))

- 1** Spooner to question spirit about woodwork (8)      goalpost (Woodwork (as in "hit the") - Spoonerism of POLL GHOST (question spirit))
- 2** The whole of eternity tormented (8)      entirety (The whole of - ETERNITY\* (anagram=tormented))
- 3** Politician with no vices or unusually tax involved in a single state (15)      neoconservative (Politician - (NO VICES OR)\* (anagram=unusually) with VAT (tax) inside (involved) all inside NEE (state of being single/unmarried))
- 5** My failing is topless bands (4)      oops (My failing - [h]OOPS (topless bands))
- 6** Ford, for example all around the boss (8-7)      director-general (Boss - DIRECTOR ([John] Ford for example) + GENERAL (all around))
- 7** About a meat show (6)      reveal (Show - RE (about) + VEAL (a meat))
- 8** Pay up unfortunately on track (6)      salary (Pay - Reversal (up) of ALAS (unfortunately) on RY (Railway/track))
- 11** Setter's out of date jam (7)      impasse (Jam - I'M (setter's) + PASSE (out of date))
- 14** Storage holds rubbish with bars (7)      striped (With bars - SD (card, computer storage) holding TRIPE (rubbish))
- 16** Unchanged in a second memorial (8)      monument (Memorial - UN\* (changed) in MOMENT (second))
- 17** Nautically, hi? (8)      amidship (Cryptically, in a nautical word, HI is amid the word SHIP)
- 19** Pays off, utter rubbish about diversion (6)      bypass (Diversion - PAYS\* (anagram=off) with BS (utter rubbish) around it)
- 20** Centre with extreme in jacuzzi (3,3)      hot tub (Jacuzzi - HUB (centre) around OTT (extreme))
- 23** So they used the first halves (4)      thus (So - TH[ey] US[ed] (first halves of the words))
